

Epistemic Insight Research Survey Consent Form

The Epistemic Insight Initiative aims to develop pupils' understanding of different types of disciplinary knowledge and how these differences might coexist in which to investigate bigger questions that bridge subject disciplines. We expect that the outcomes from the initiative will help create a curriculum framework for schools that will enable young people to think more deeply and critically about Big Questions across a wide range of subjects.
